

## Focus for the week and important dates for your diary

Year 3	<p>Maths: Place value continues with more ordering, games and using resources.</p> <p>English: We will be innovating the story of Cave baby, delving in new vocabulary and having a go at writing stories independently.</p> <p>Topic: Stone age continues.</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: We are looking at the value of the digits in 4-digit numbers and partitioning and recombining them. We will recap the 4-x table and use doubling to link it to the 8-x table.</p> <p>English: We are beginning to plan and write our 'portal stories' using all the lovely language we have been collecting.</p> <p>PSHE: We are focussing on good relationships and relearning how to work and play together in the classroom and playground. We will talk about trusted adults and reminding the children about our school worry box.</p> <p><b>PE next week: 4TR Monday and Tuesday; 4NG Tuesday; 4GS Friday. Please do not worry if your child either comes in PE kit and there is no PE or they do not wear it on a PE day as we are all getting used to the new rota.</b></p>
Year 5	<p>Maths: We will be starting our work on formal written strategies by looking at column addition of 3, 4 and 5-digit numbers, including exchanging.</p> <p>English: We will be exploring descriptive language through setting and character descriptions.</p> <p>Topic: We will be investigating which materials make good electrical conductors and insulators.</p> <p>Art: Over the next few weeks, we will be creating an Egyptian collage. Please could you start having a look at home for any spare materials that could be useful– e.g. fabric samples; wrapping paper; shiny paper; buttons; feathers; sequins; old magazines etc. Many thanks!</p> <p>PE next week:</p> <p><b>5PD – Wednesday and Thursday</b></p> <p><b>5SR – Wednesday and Thursday</b></p> <p><b>5ES – Wednesday and Friday</b></p>
Year 6	<p>Maths: We will be focusing on the written method of short multiplication (345 x 6) and developing reasoning skills around the concept of multiplication.</p> <p>English: After finishing our non-chronological reports on polar bears, the children will be presenting their work in an "exploding" book.</p> <p>Foundation: Science will be adaptation, art will be our watercolour polar scene and we will design and make our polar soft toy.</p>
