Year 3	<p>Maths: We will be learning how to add up 2, 2 digit numbers in columns. We will use dienes and Place Value counters to help with adding.</p> <p>English: We will be starting to write our non-chronological reports about stone age animals, mainly appearance and habitat.</p> <p>Topic: Stone Age activities continued.</p> <p>Science: Sedimentary rock experiments continue and then learning about metamorphic rocks.</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: After some fantastic mental addition and subtraction, we will be moving on to adding 3/4-digit numbers in columns using resources to support our understanding. We will be finishing the 2, 4 and 8 x tables with a quiz to assess what facts we know and which ones we still need to practise. Thank you for helping your child learn these tables at home.</p> <p>English: We are going to be learning the Hindu creation story off by heart using actions, symbols and playing games. Then, we are going to be writing our own creation stories '<i>How the Dojo Created The World</i>'. Very exciting!</p> <p>Topic: We are learning about The Prince Regent and his role in how Brighton became a holiday destination.</p> <p>Art: Soon, we will be starting work on our Royal Pavilion collages. If you have any suitable materials for collaging – foil sweet wrappers, patterned wrapping paper; tin foil; fabric; sequins; tissue paper etc – we will be very grateful for them.</p> <p>Thank you to all parents who have accepted our invitation to Class Dojo. Year 5	<p>Maths: We will be using inverse operations and looking at multi-step word problems involving addition and subtraction.</p>

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	<p>English: We will be continuing our story describing an Egyptian tomb discovery, focusing on scene-setting and descriptive devices, such as noun phrases, powerful verbs and similes.</p> <p>Topic: This week, we will be learning about ancient Egyptian gods and the afterlife.
