Year 3	<p>Maths: Now that we have become more confident with mental subtraction methods, subtraction continues with written methods. We will be mastering column subtraction.</p> <p>English: We shall be recounting the fossil hunters most infamous find... ask your children all about Mary Anning! We are hoping the children will use strong verbs and adverbs to help strengthen their descriptions.</p> <p>Topic: Stone Age food.</p> <p>Science: Water testing on various stone types.</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: Moving on to measurements, we will be looking at length, measuring different things around the classroom and playground before converting between metres, cm and mm. We will be continuing the 6x table.
